Here we are in the third week of 2011 and we are pleased to have completed the February edition of the *HotSheet*. With this edition we have also developed a *Special Burning Issues Supplement* which focuses on *A Systems Pathology Approach to Post-Surgical Patients with Anxiety*. The edition was authored by Jason Alter, PhD from Aureon Biosciences.

You also may have noticed that we have also just completed the first edition for 2011 of the *Chapter News!* and you can find all of these documents on the Us TOO website. We have also recently completed the Annual Report on Us TOO's 2009 activities, which also will be placed on the website soon.

All of the publications once again contain a great deal of information, suggestions and examples of volunteers and other people who have made prostate cancer a high priority and focus. There is no doubt in my mind we are seeing much more activity in the battle against prostate cancer, what a great and inspiring thing to see.

So, what is ahead for 2011 at Us TOO now that we have celebrated our 20th Anniversary? The Board of Directors will hold its First Quarter meeting here in Chicago in early March with three others to follow. On its agenda this year is an examination of our current 2008-2011 Corporate Plan, finding several new Board members to serve, assuring completion of our annual audit and tax filings and implementing the 2011 Workplan which they approved at the December 2010 Annual Meeting.

Highlights of the 2011 Workplan include a new publication on Advanced Prostate Cancer with a target completion date of March, an Us TOO University Conference to be held in August, the Chicago-area Seventh Annual SEA Blue Walk/Run event in September and a fourth round of Edward C. Kaps *Hope Awards* to recognize the efforts of volunteers.

Also during 2011 will be collaborative efforts with other organizations on the advocacy and policy front, on the awareness side with Rick Lyke's *Pints for Prostates* project with local events throughout the year, the *Sneakers at Work Day* campaign in September and another new exciting sports related prostate cancer awareness initiative which will be announced in mid-February.

Thank you for all you are doing out there and for your involvement with Us TOO, we have an exciting year ahead!
